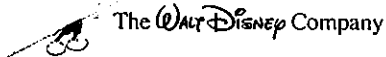

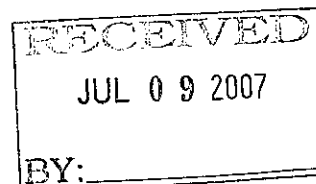

This JOINT VENTURE AGREEMENT ("Agreement") is made on AUGUST 11, 2008, between JO ANNA MCCORMICK CANZONERI and

The Joint Venturers have agreed to make contributions to a common fund for the purpose of acquiring and holding:

The Joint Venturers consider it advisable to acquire and to hold their business interest through a nominee so as to avoid the necessity of numerous separate agreements, to maintain the legal title to the business interest in a simple and practicable form, and to facilitate the collection and distribution of the profits accruing under the business interest, and
